
TEACHING METHODS

- Monthly Unit test.


DEPARTMENTAL CHALLENGES

- Poor economical background of students so they give priority to activities like agriculture for their livelihood before education.


STRENGTH YEAR WISE




STUDENTS APPEARED YEAR WISE
